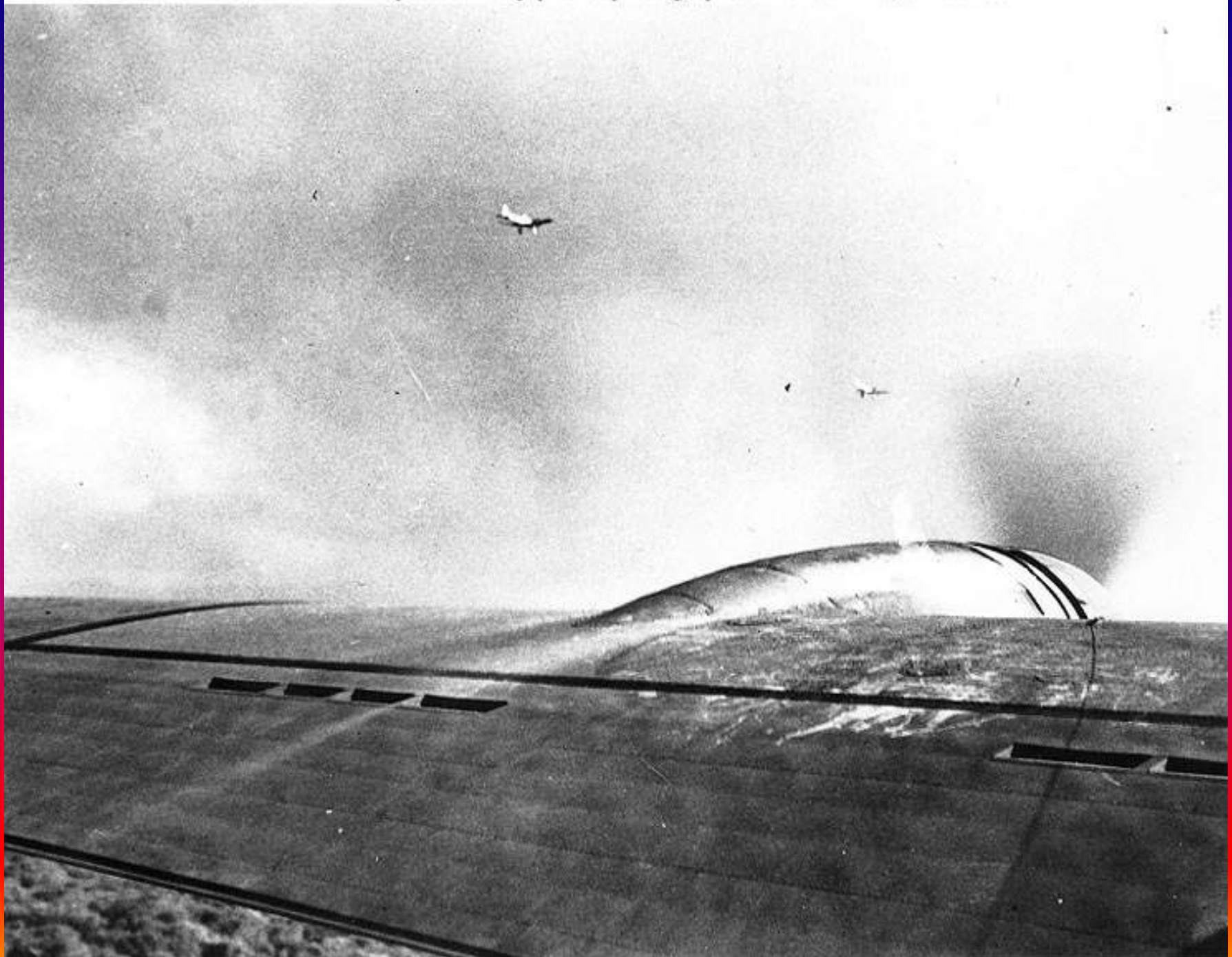




The submarine base and oil storage tanks on Oct. 13, 1941. None of these facilities were bombed, a fatal mistake for the Japanese.

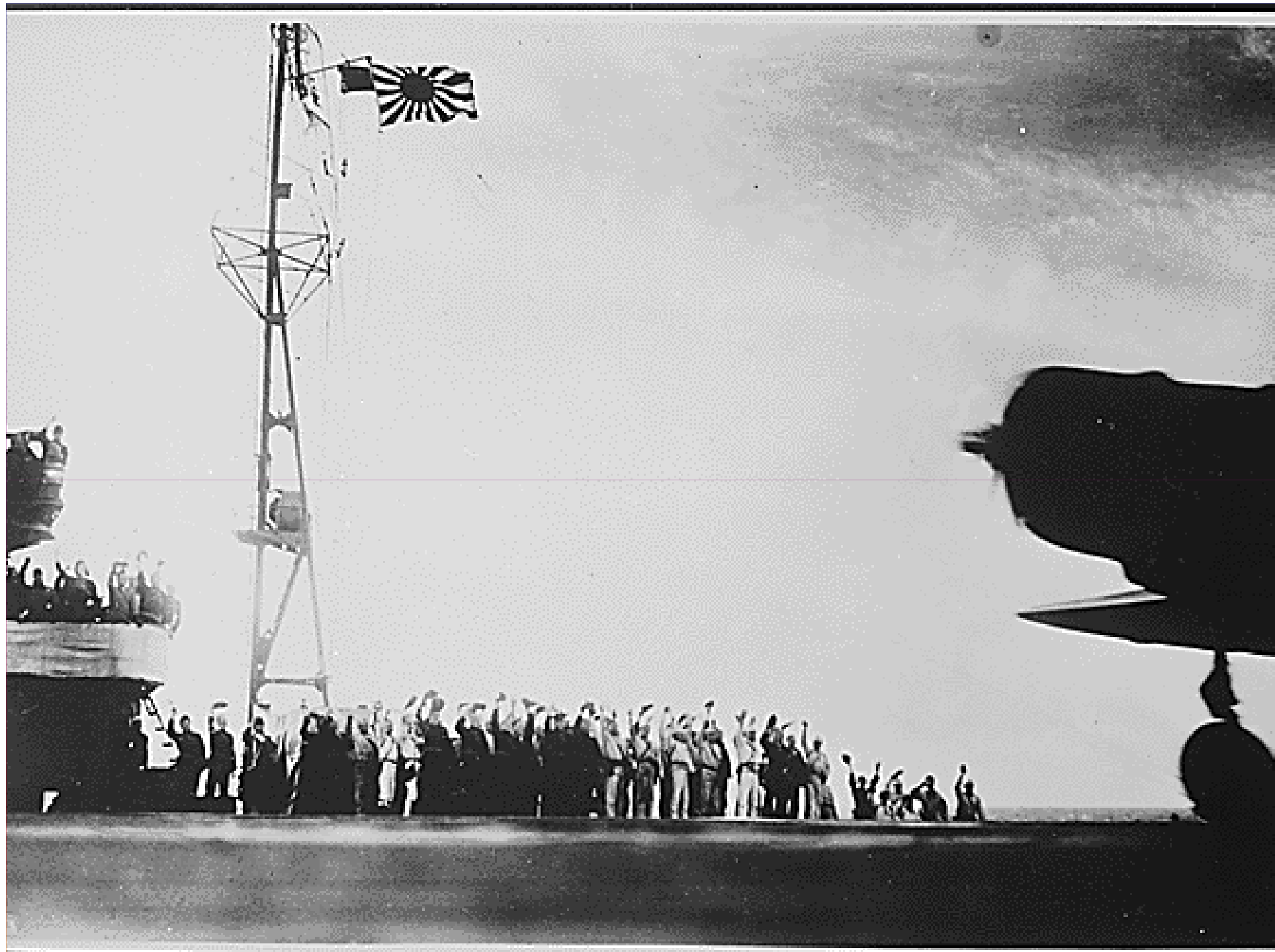

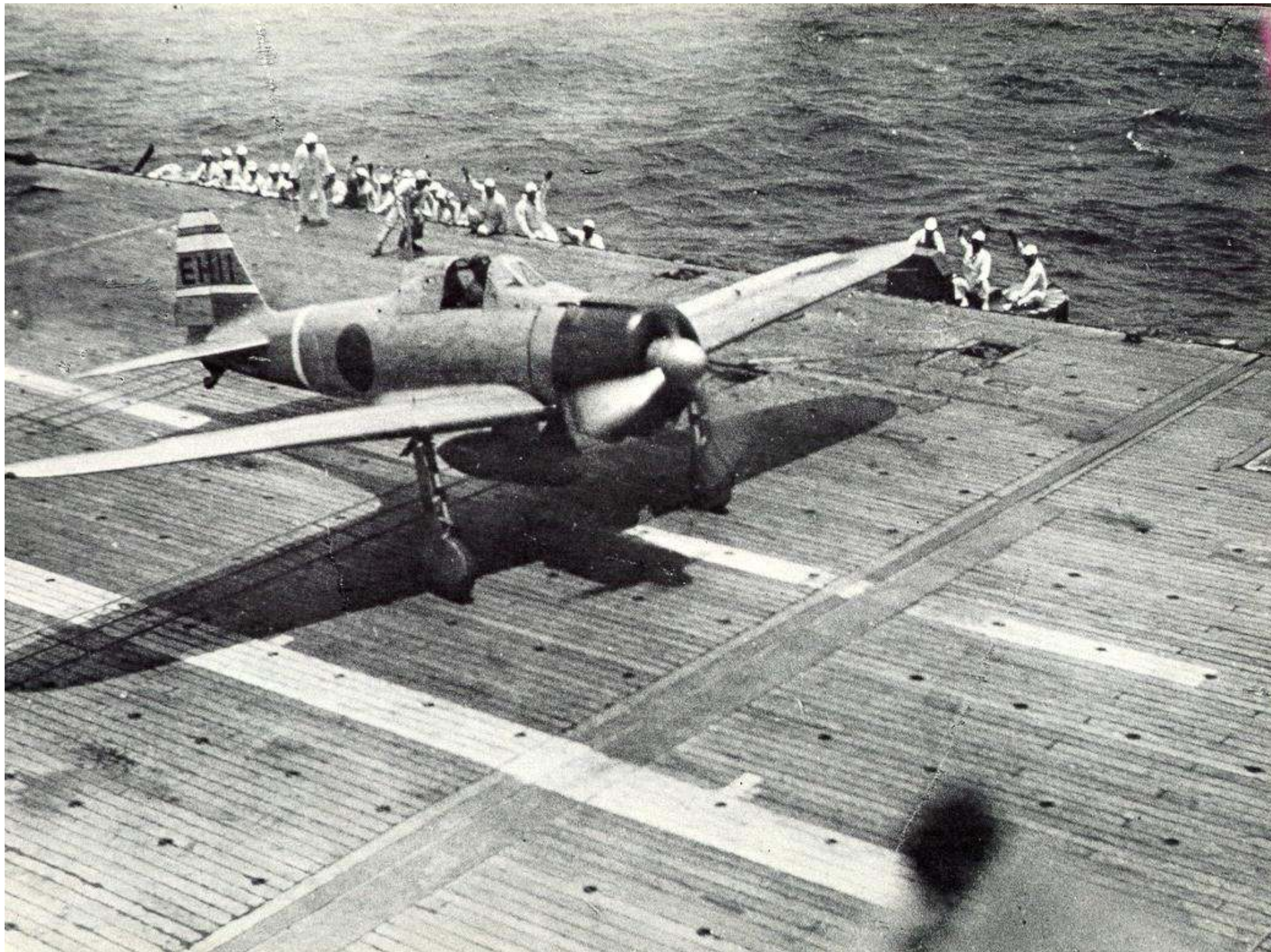

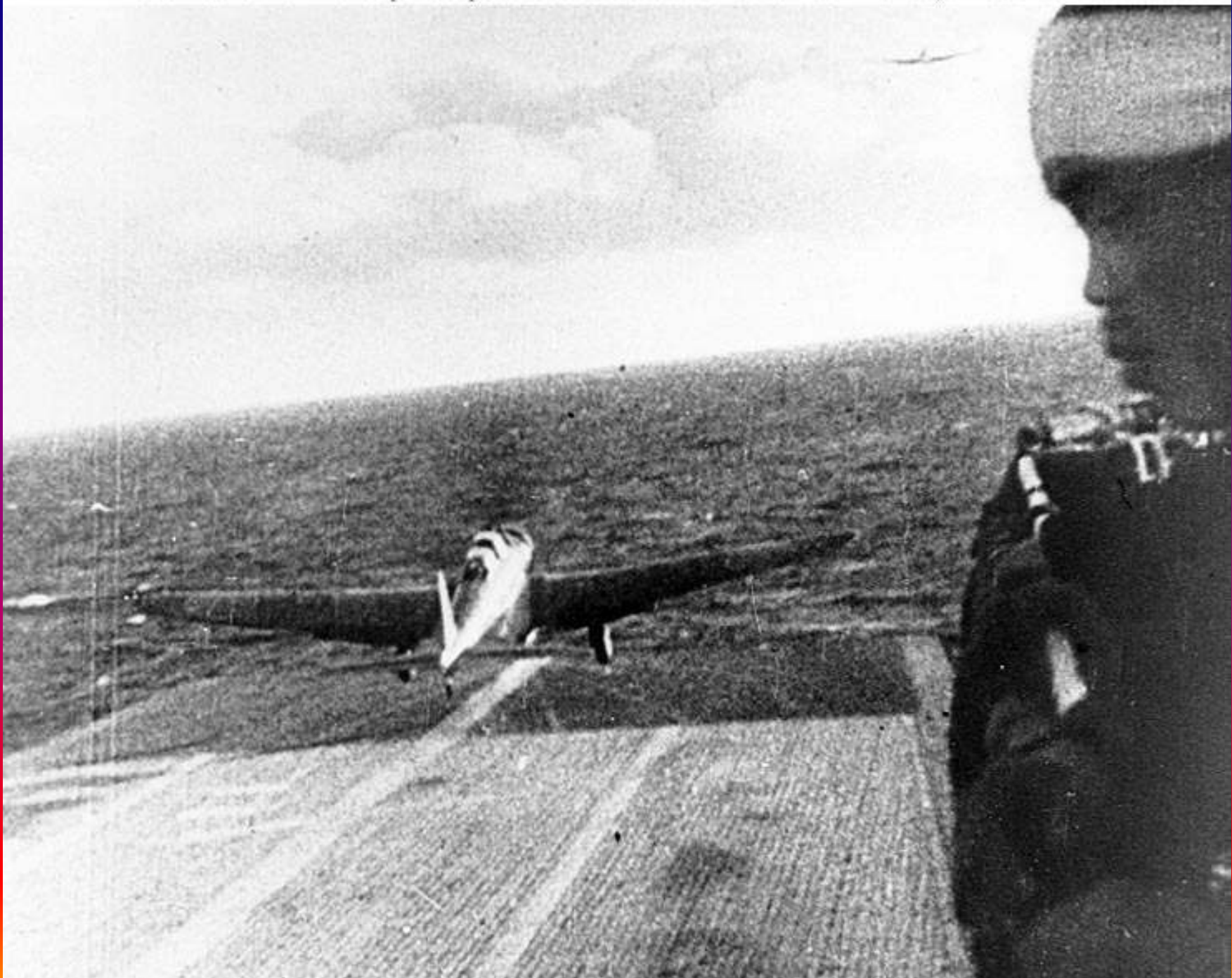

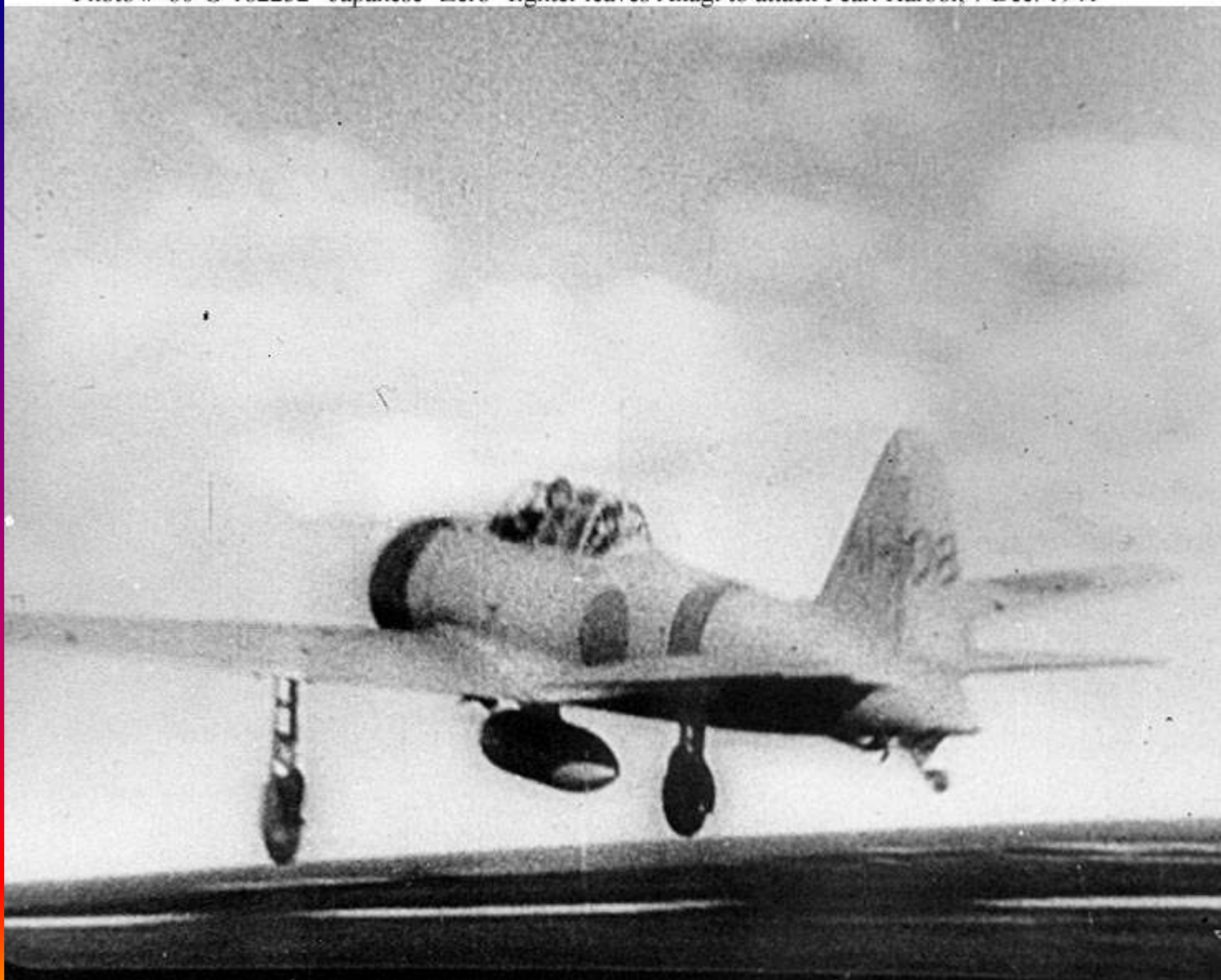

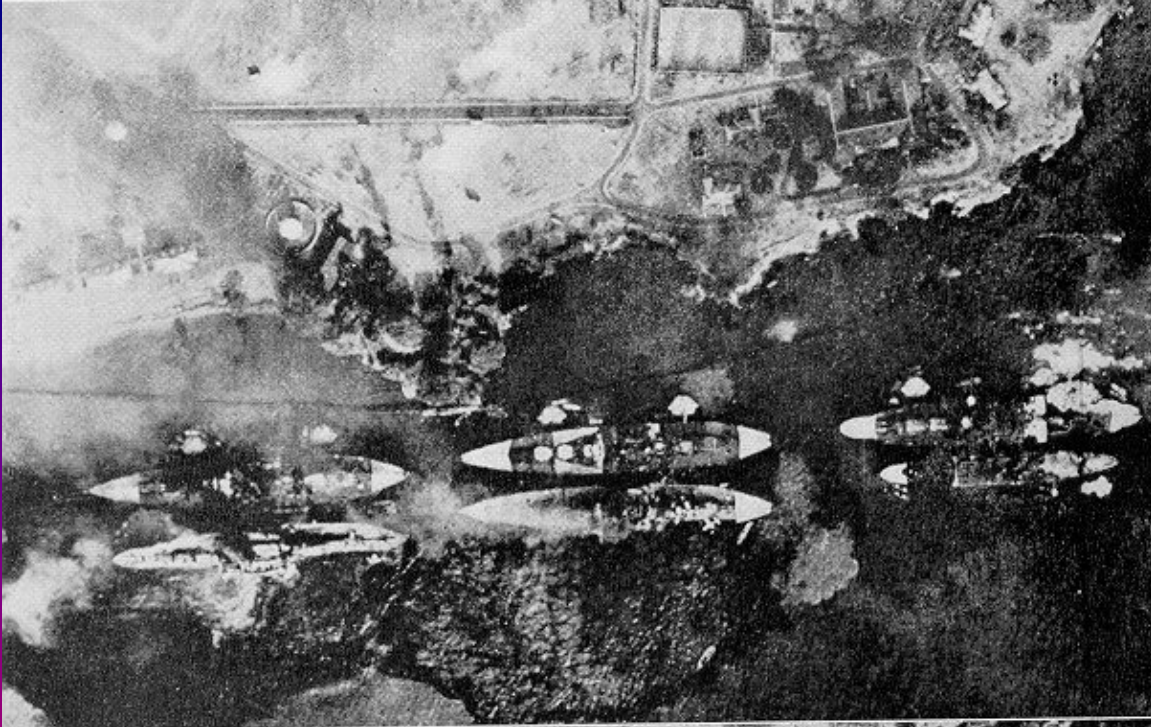


Photo # 80-G-32792 Wide angle view of Pearl Harbor during the Japanese attack, 7 Dec. 1941

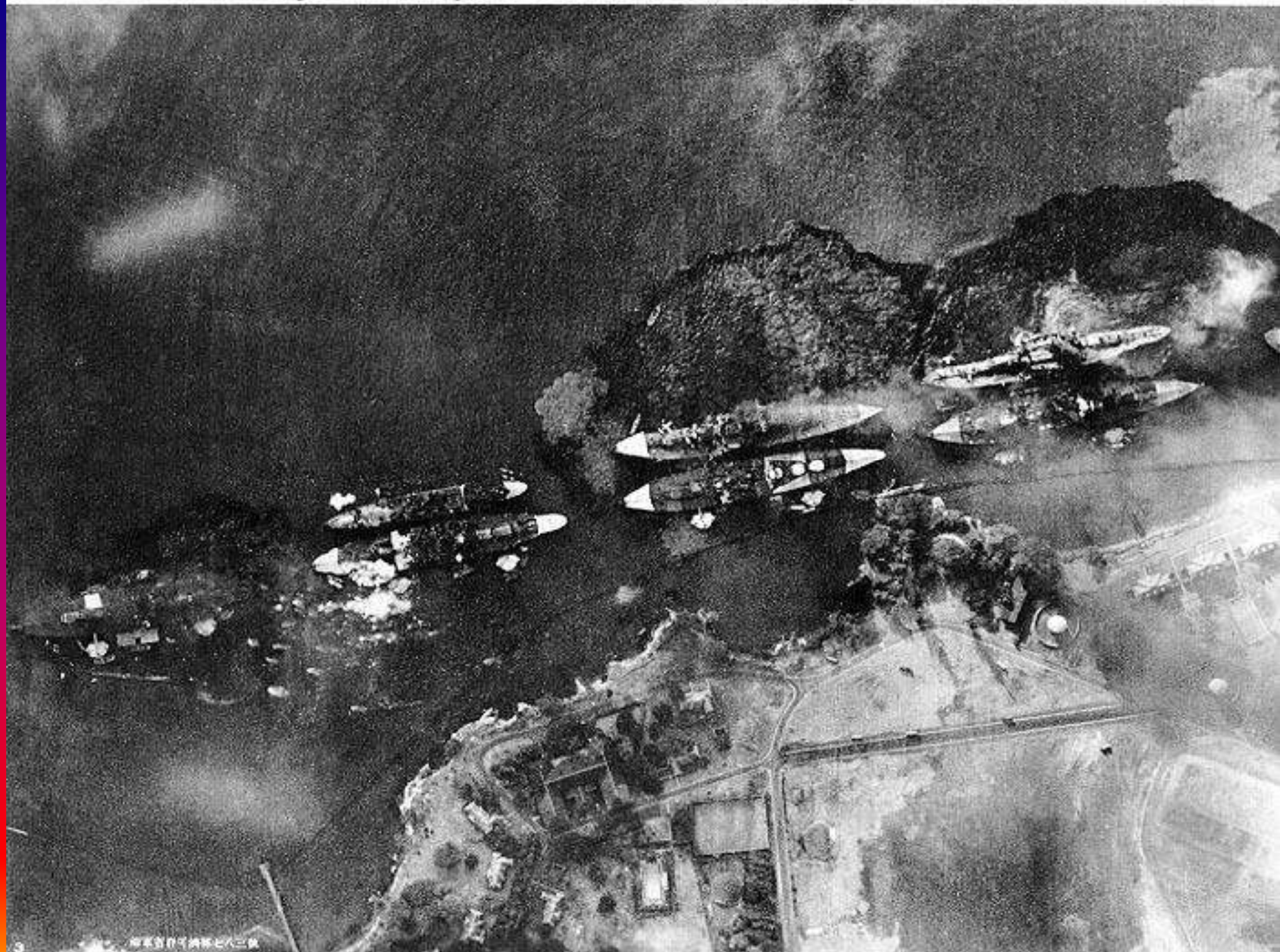

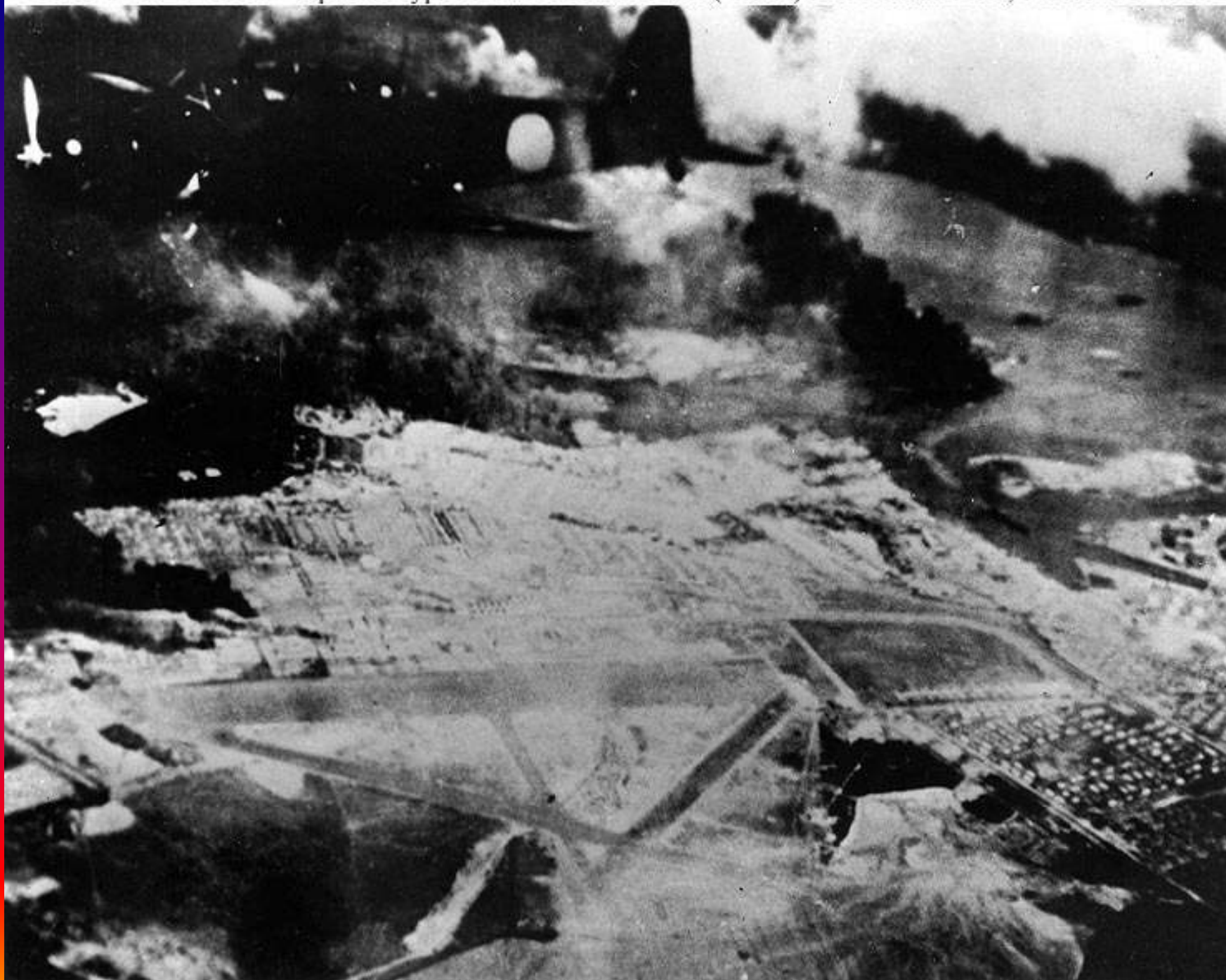

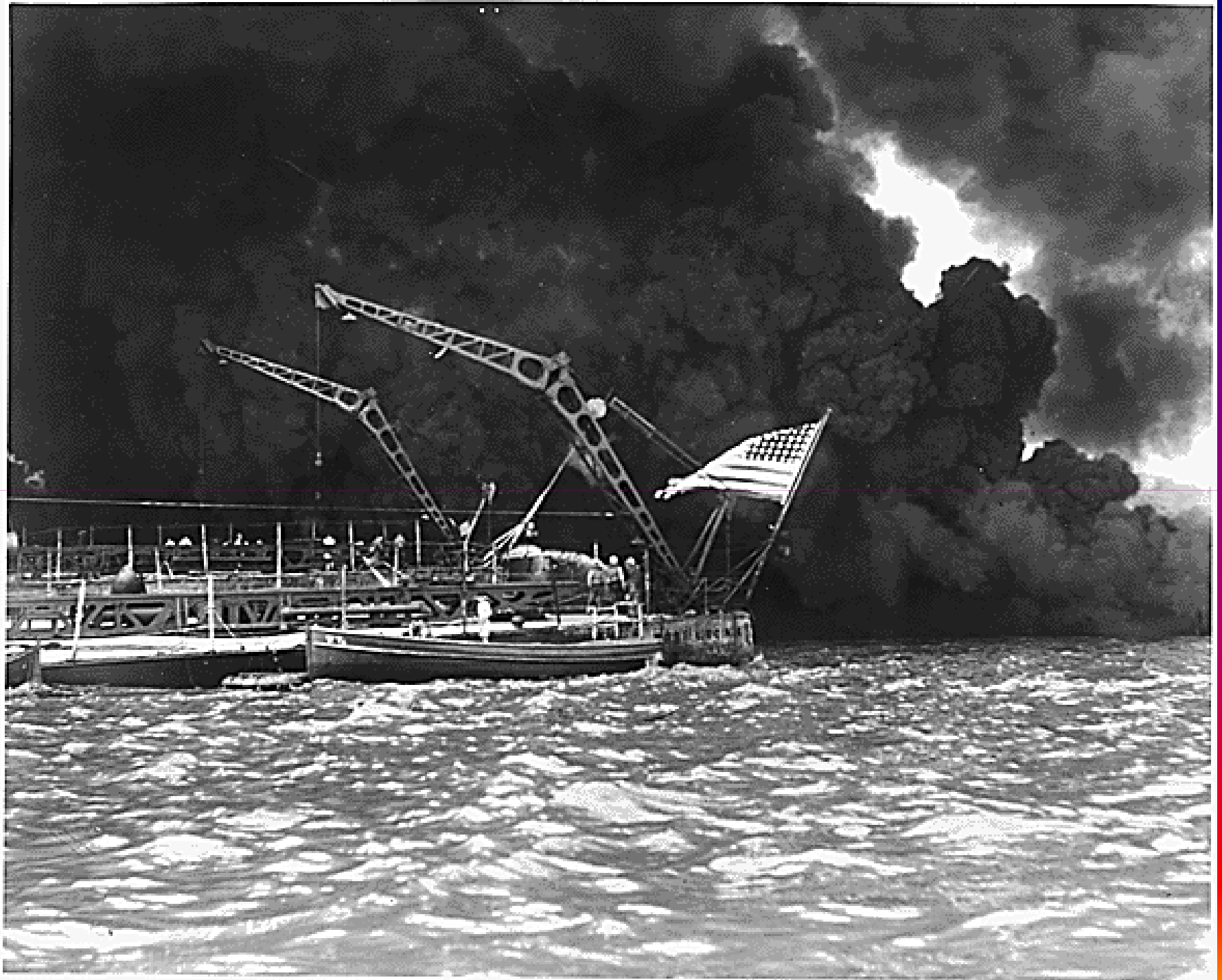




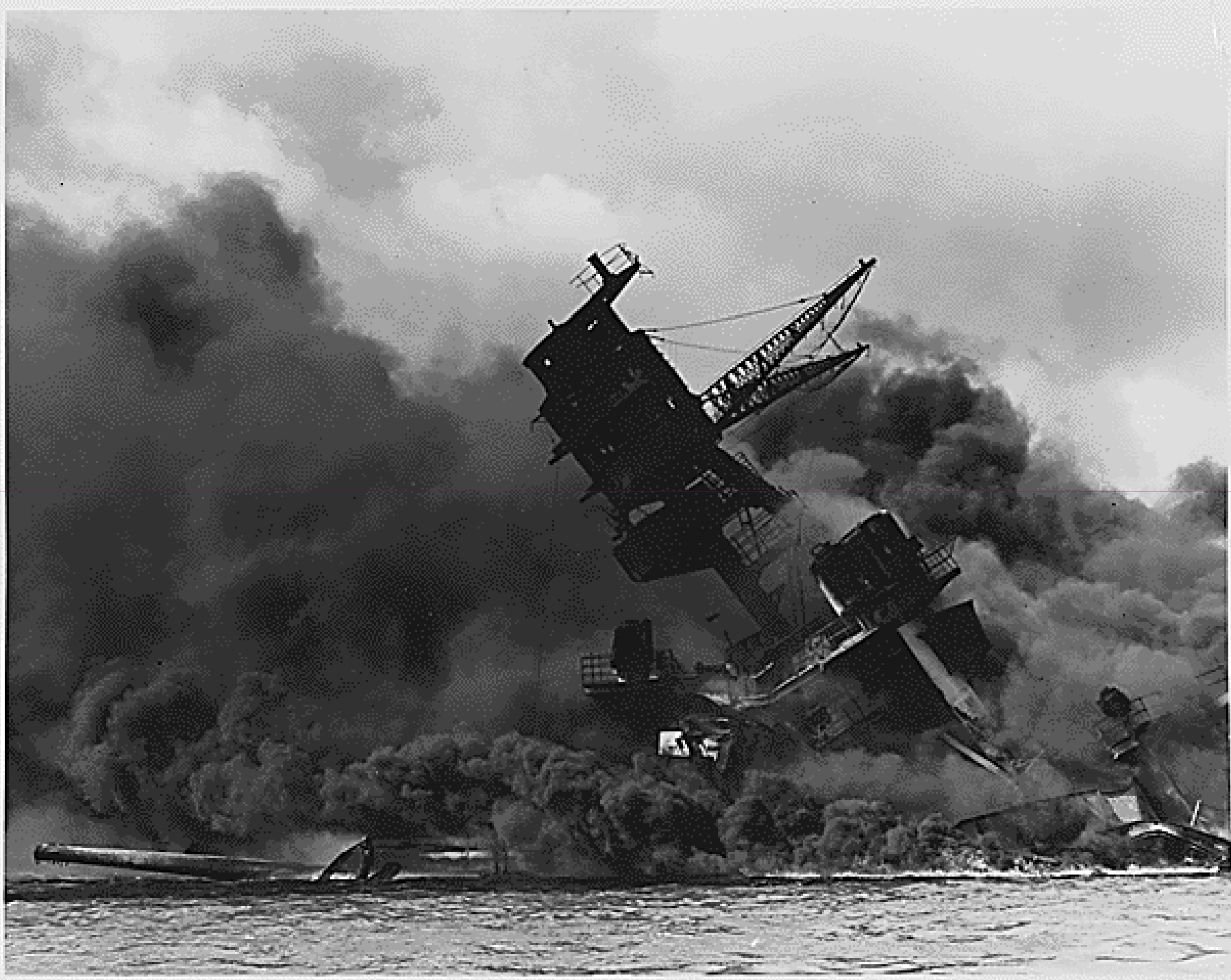


Photo # NH 97379 Forward superstructure of the wrecked USS Arizona burning at Pearl Harbor, 7 Dec. 1941

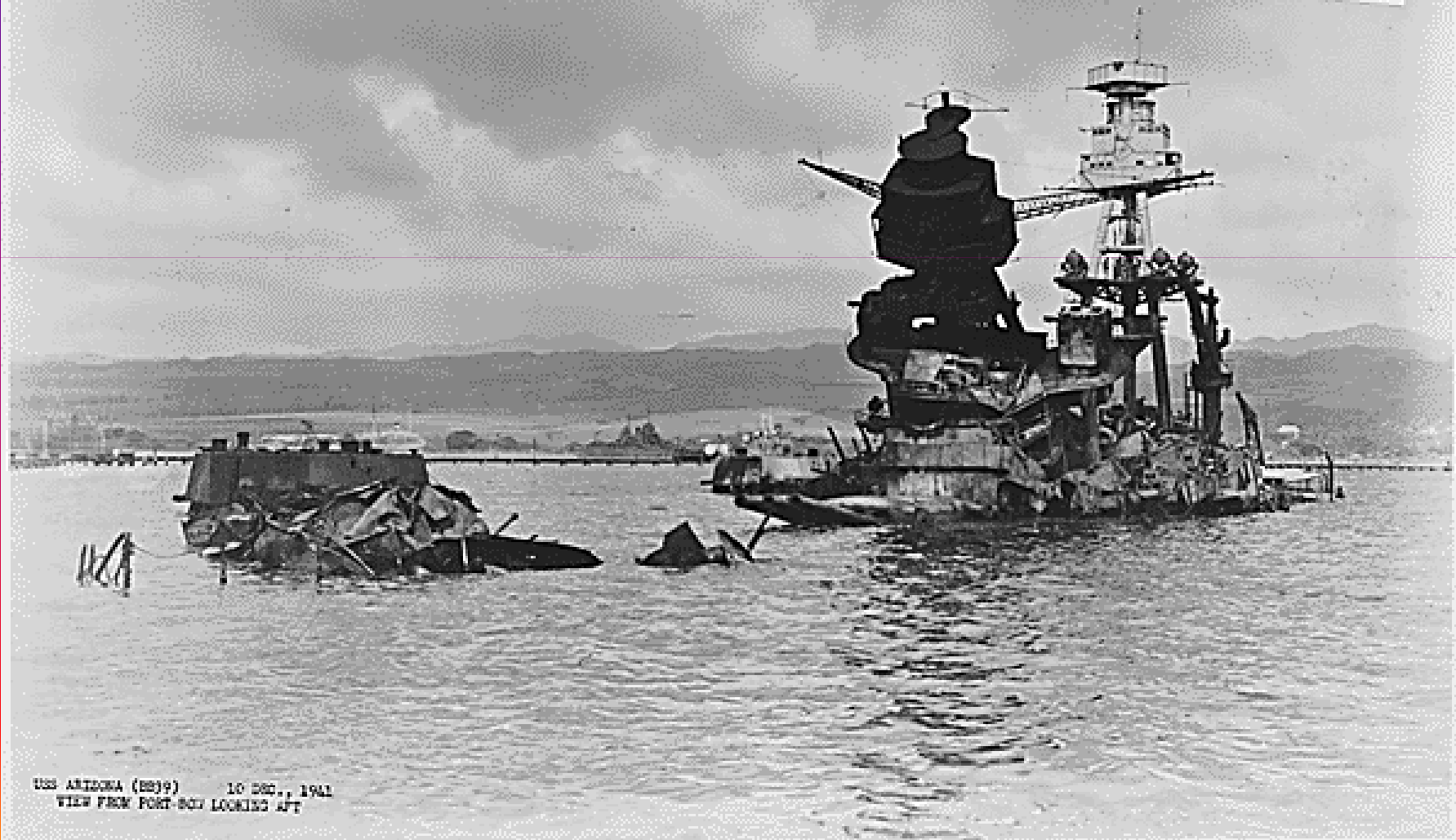

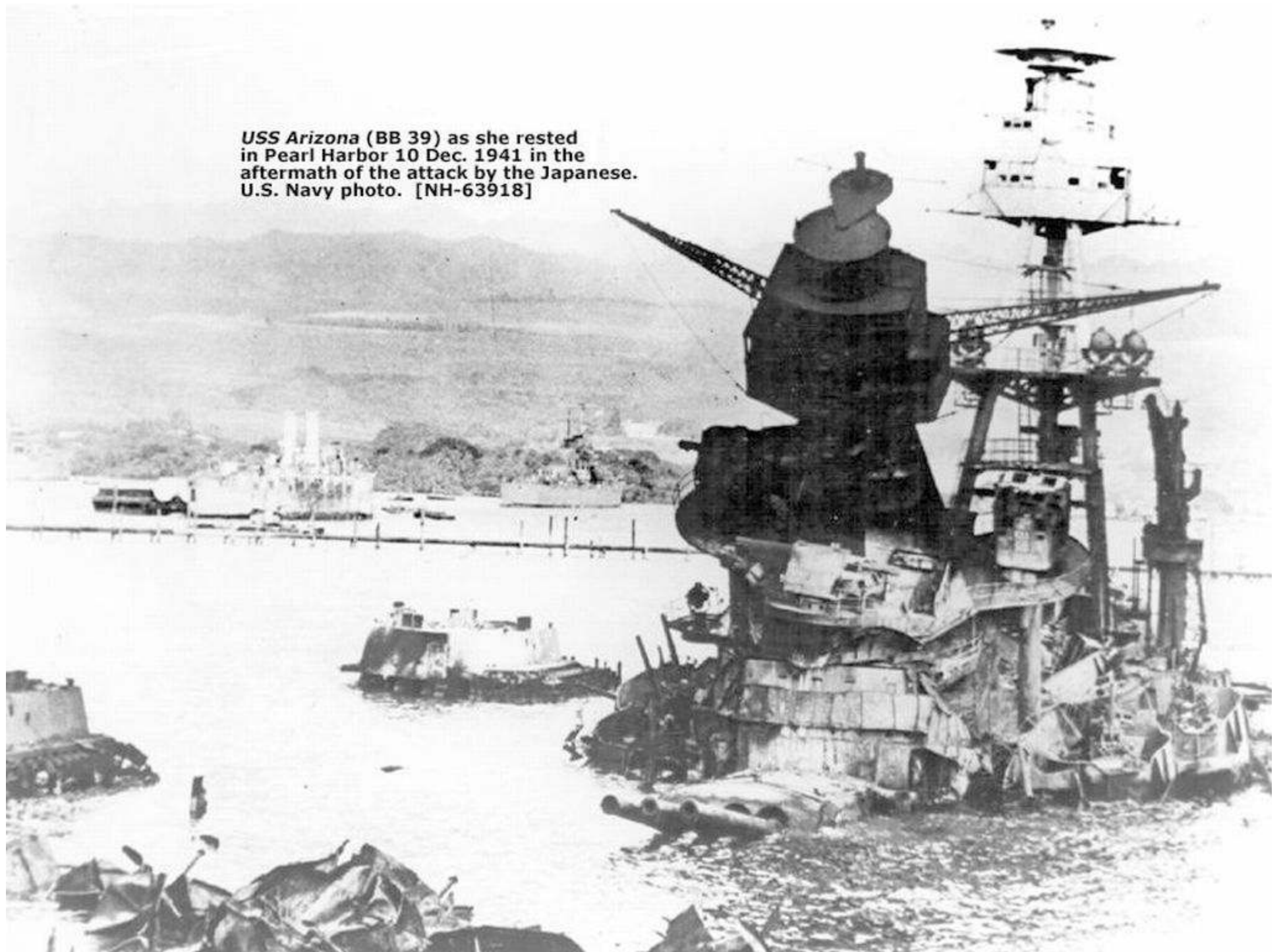

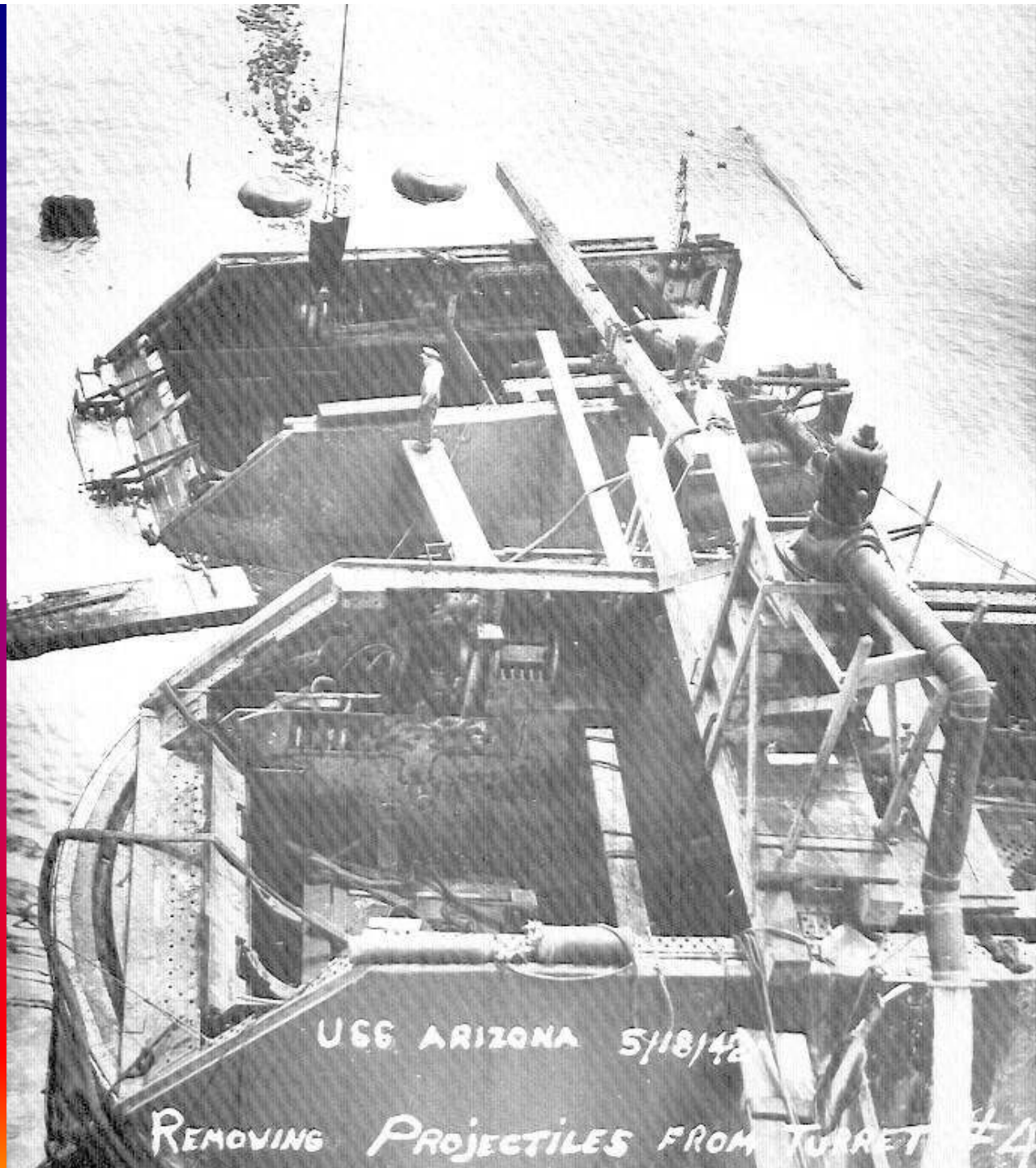

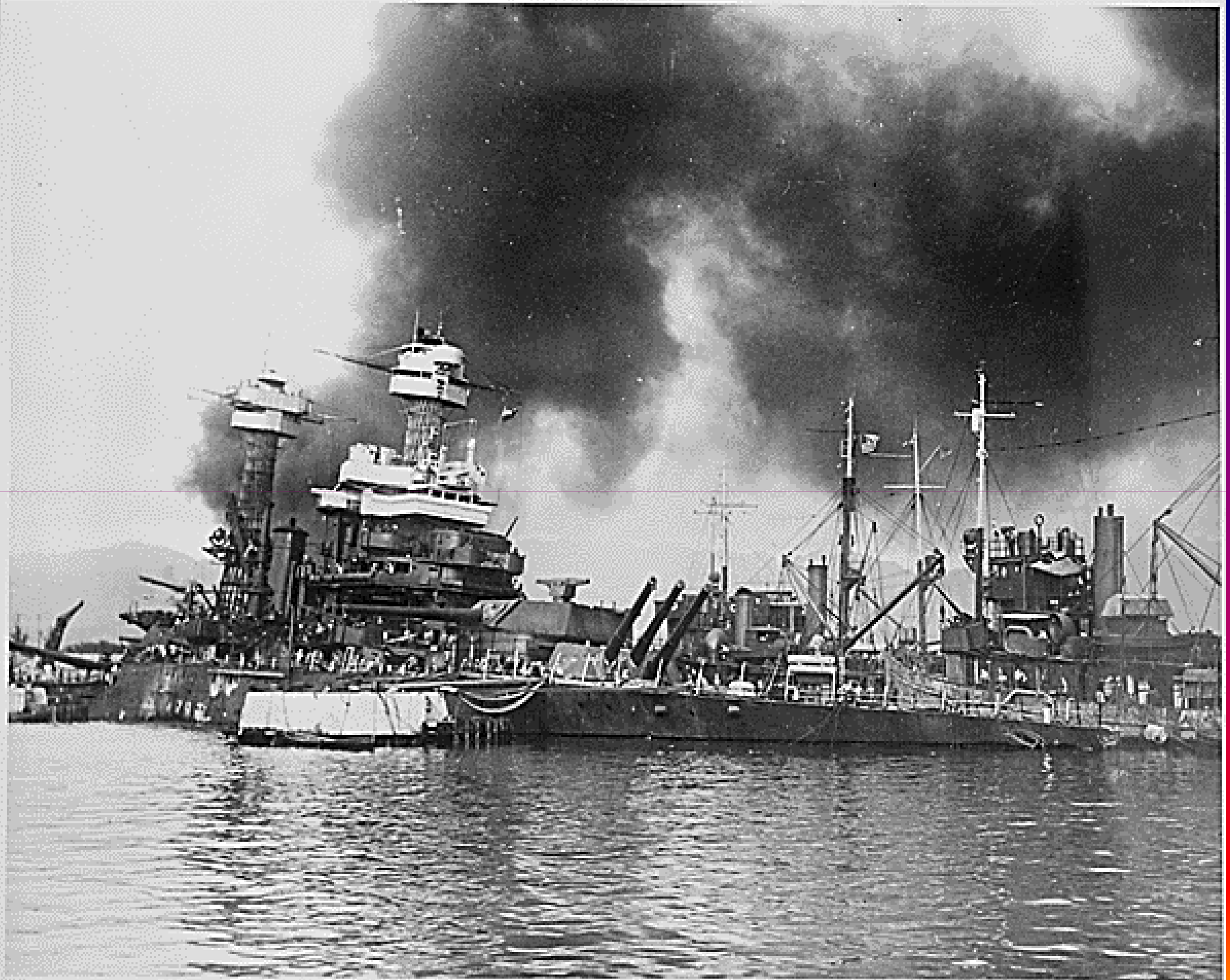


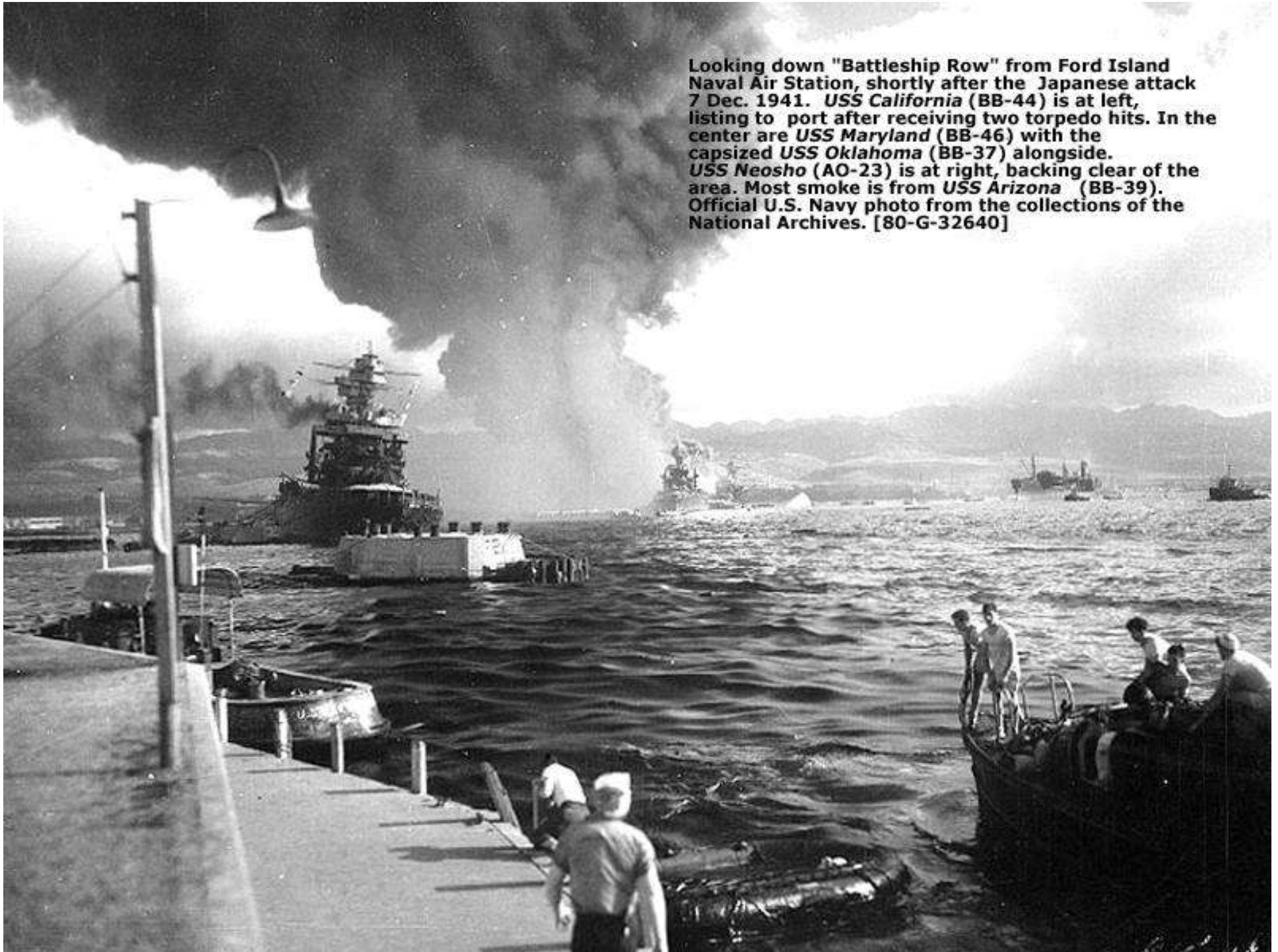

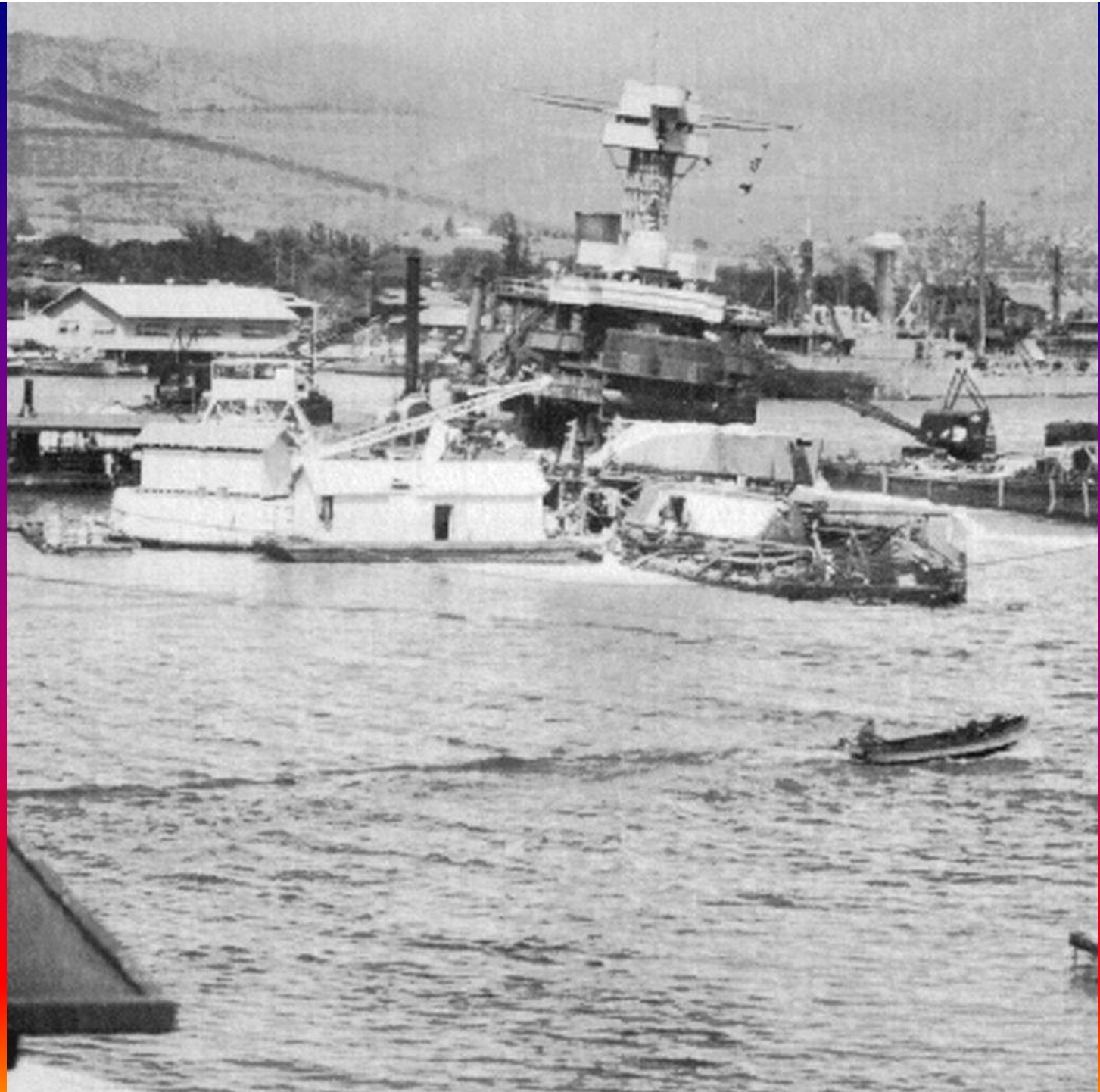

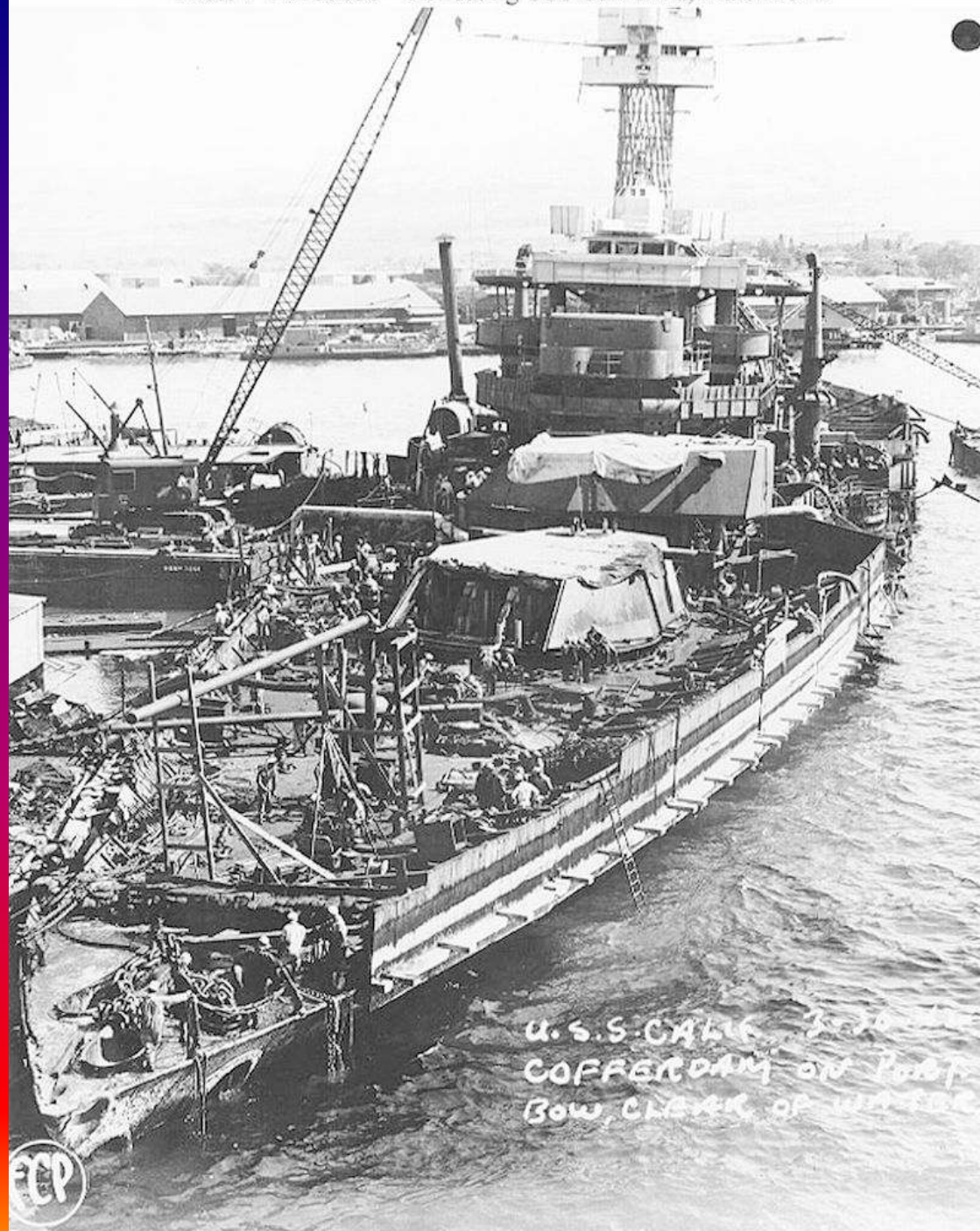

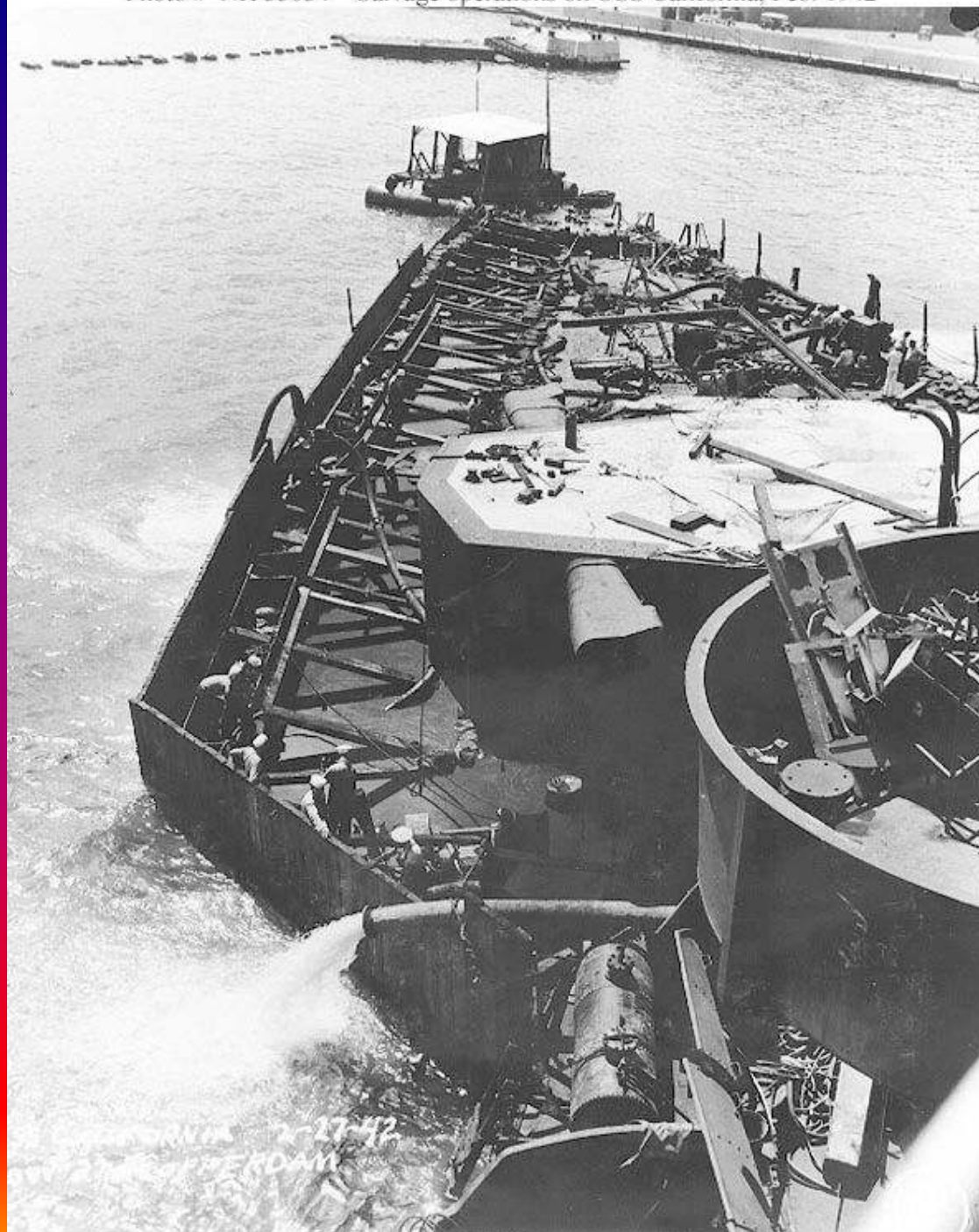

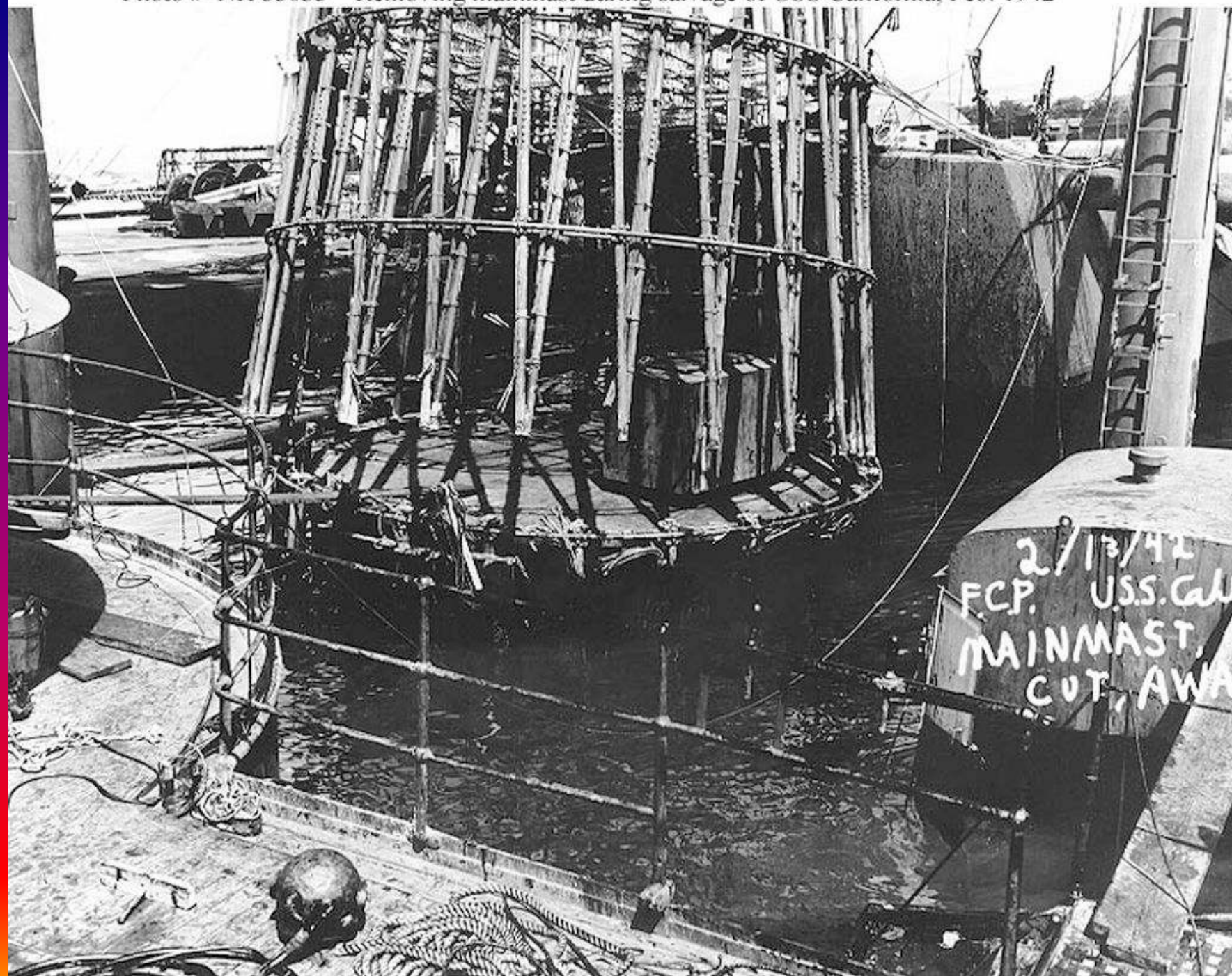

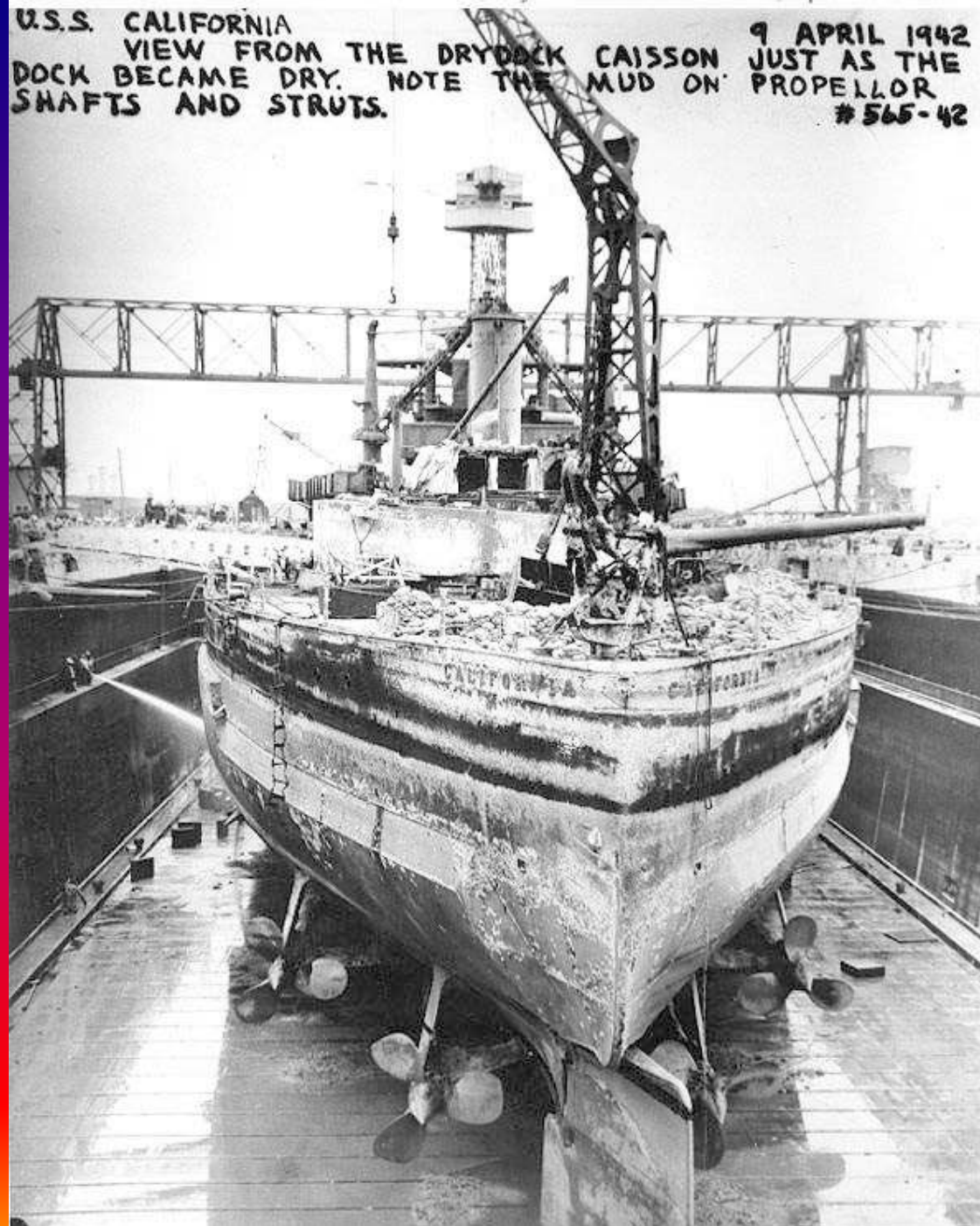

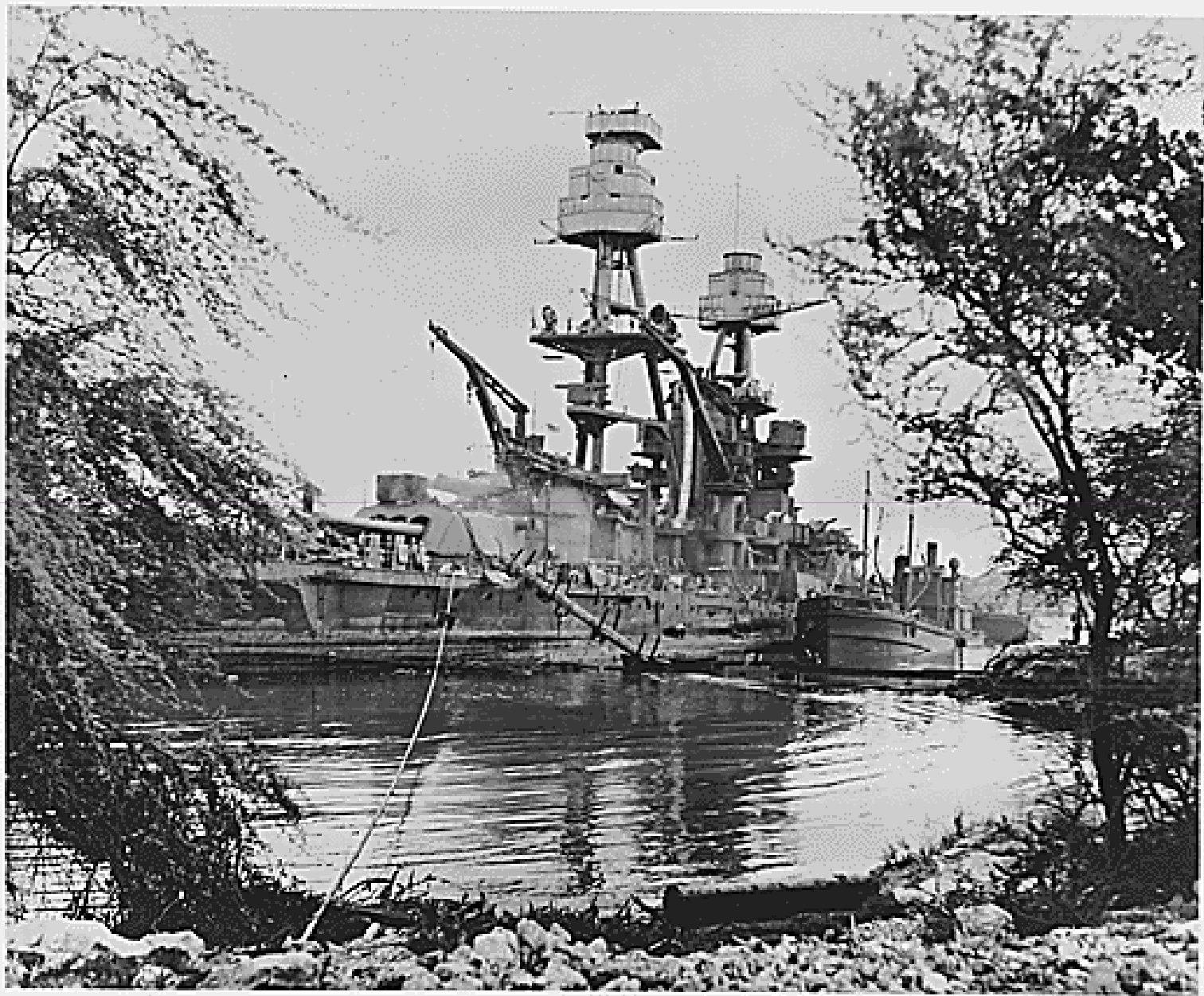

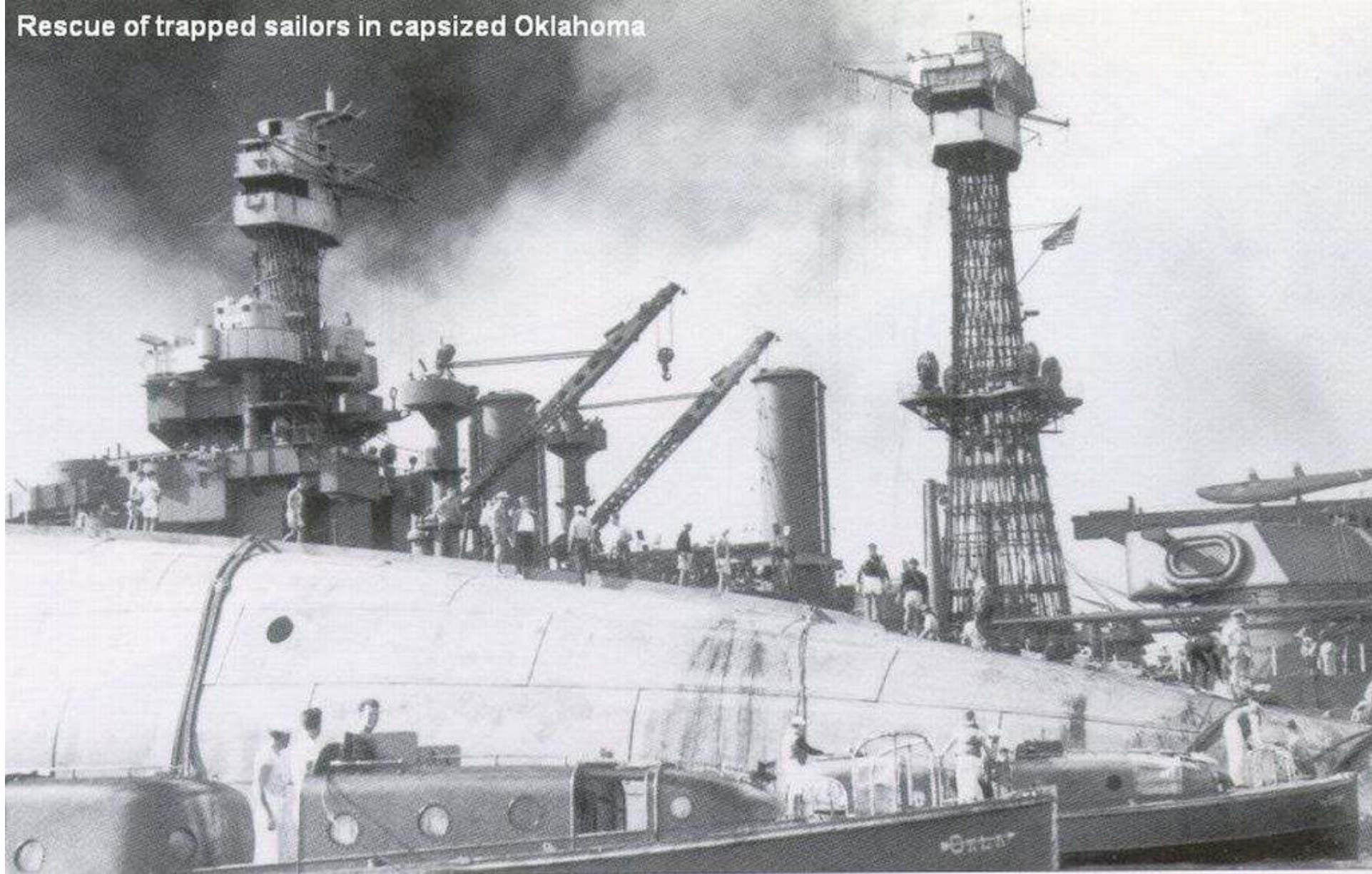

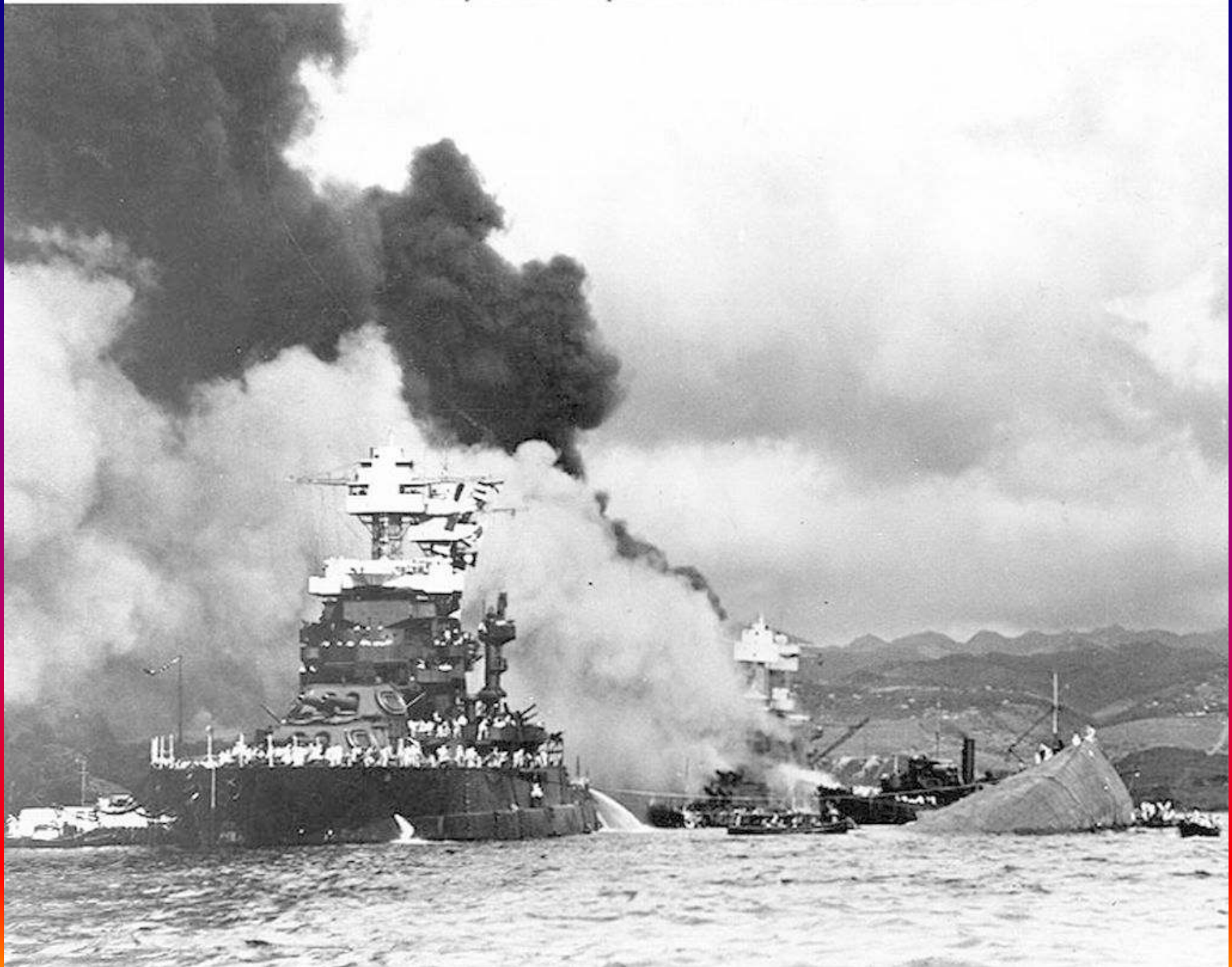

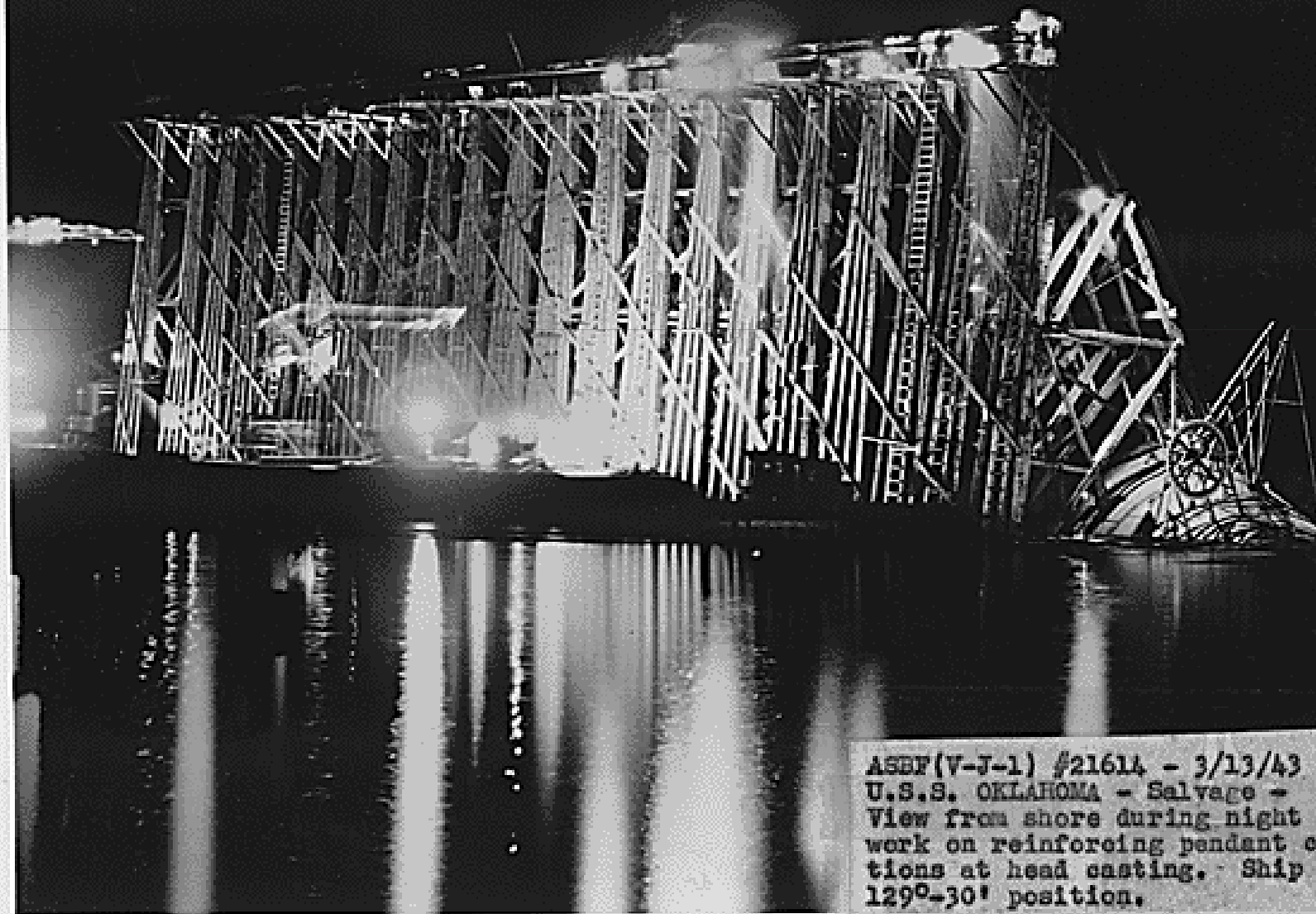
